

Copyright & Intellectual Property Policy

1. Introduction & Ownership

Unless otherwise stated, content published by The Daily Round is owned by or licensed to The Daily Round and is protected by applicable copyright, intellectual property, trademark, database, and related laws.

This policy applies across all platforms operated by The Daily Round, including:

- the website,
- newsletters,
- downloadable resources,
- social media channels,
- videos,

- and other digital or printed materials connected to the publication.

8. AI & Automated Use Restrictions
